PAYMENT OF CRIMINAL MONETARY PENALTIES

If the Judgment in a Criminal Case required payment of a fine, restitution, and/or Crime Victim's Fund assessment, you have likely signed a payment agreement with your U.S. Probation Officer.

The U.S. Probation Office does not accept payments. You must make your payment to the Clerk of the Court's Office. No cash will be accepted. Cashier's Check, money order or personal check should be made payable to: **Clerk, U.S. District Court**

In addition, criminal debt payments may be made over the telephone with a debit or credit card by calling the District Court Clerk's Office. Receipts are mailed to you for phone payments.
